Frank Lehmann is Germany's best-known stock market expert. The business journalist shaped ARD's financial reporting for almost 20 years and is considered a profound and humorous expert on the stock market.

Frank Lehmann has been the face of the Frankfurt stock exchange for many years, reporting on the stock market with expert knowledge and humour for ARD's Morgenmagazin, Mittagmagazin, Tagesschau and Tagesthemen. In 2001, the economic expert took over the stock exchange television department and from then on initiated and presented the daily ARD programme "Börse aktuell". With up to three million viewers, it became one of the most successful TV stock market programmes in Europe, also because Frank Lehmann provides up-to-date, in-depth and clear information.

The journalist ended his work for ARD in 2006 and has since passed on his knowledge of stock market psychology and investor behaviour in lectures. Because of his talent for presenting even complex issues in an easily understandable and investor-oriented manner, he is in great demand as a speaker. He explains the rules of the stock exchange and financial world with a high level of expertise.
