Dagur Sigurdsson is head coach for the German national handball team. He is said to be the architect of the German handball success story.

Before becoming head coach for the German national handball team, Dagur was head coach of the German Bundesliga team Füchse Berlin which he led to winning the 2014 DHB Cup.

During his active career as a handball player in Iceland, Dagur was member of the Icelandic national team and played 215 international matches. He is a five time Icelandic cup winner and competed in numerous world championships and European championships as well as the Olympic Games in 2004.

Since August 2014 he is the head coach for the German national handball team. Dagur managed to turn the team, which was then in a deep crisis, into the European Champion 2016.

Dagur Sigurdsson knows how to form successful teams, how to improve team spirit and to stimulate motivation. And as a speaker he knows how to pass this on to his audience in an impressing and lasting way.
