She believes that the Web3 and it's tokenized applications can shift the dynamics of our socio-economic systems, which is why a good understanding of the technology and it's applications is fundamental to the process of co-creating this new collective infrastructure and its applications.

Shermin has a long track record of public speaking about Blockchain, Cryptocurrencies, the Web3 and the future of technologies in general – from prestigious community conferences such as TedX, The Next Web or Re:publica, to private events for companies and institutions such as Vodafone, Audi, IMF and the Wordbank.
