Geoff White is one of the world's leading investigative journalists covering cybercrime, organised crime and the hidden impact of technology on business and society. For more than two decades, he has investigated hackers, fraudsters, money launderers and cybercriminal networks, helping organisations understand the rapidly evolving risks of the digital age. His reporting has appeared on BBC News, Sky News, Audible and in The Sunday Times, among many other international media outlets.

As an author, Geoff has established himself as a leading voice on cybercrime and financial crime. His latest book, *Rinsed* (Penguin Random House, 2024), examines how technology has transformed the global money laundering industry and was described by the Financial Times as "riveting." He is also the author of *The Lazarus Heist*, based on the BBC podcast that topped the UK Apple Podcast charts, and *Crime Dot Com*, which was named one of Wired magazine's most fascinating books of 2020.

Geoff has also created several acclaimed podcast series, including *The Dark Web*, *Artificial Intelligence: Friend or Foe?* and *Cybercrime Investigations*, making complex developments in cybersecurity and emerging technologies accessible to a broad audience.

An experienced keynote speaker, Geoff has delivered more than 300 presentations in over a dozen countries for organisations including Microsoft, HSBC, Mastercard, Sky and Atos. Combining investigative journalism with compelling real-world case studies, he explains cyber threats, fraud, artificial intelligence and digital trust in a way that is both engaging and highly relevant for business leaders. He also regularly moderates conferences and panel discussions and co-created the interactive stage production *The Secret Life of Your Mobile Phone*, which demonstrates how personal data is collected and exploited in the digital world.
