He supports founding teams, shareholders, and investors in phases of growth, transformation, and succession. With Generation Tech Partners, Daniel Szabo is shaping a new playing field: micro-private equity with AI enablement. As a lecturer in “Artificial Intelligence for Business Leaders” at the Frankfurt School of Finance & Management, he teaches how companies can strategically anchor AI and make it operationally usable.
